



The **Jobs Plus Module** in Tracking At-A-Glance® (TAAG) captures enrollment in the program, identification of resident needs, and verification of employment, living wage, and continuous employment. The module also has a dedicated screen for recording JPEID. To facilitate data entry, the JPEID records can be documented for a group of residents at one time. TAAG's **Jobs Plus Module** automatically generates the HUD-required report for this program. This report is automatically updated each time a countable activity is entered in TAAG.


